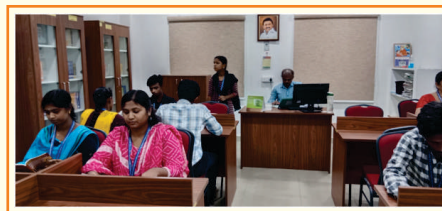

- ✂ Students should wear clean and decent dress. Wearing Jeans, T. Shirts, Jeans type cotton pants are strictly prohibited inside the campus.
- ✂ Boys should tuck-in their shirts and wear only Black/Brown leather shoes while they are inside the campus.
- ✂ Male students are asked to have a neatly shaved (or) trimmed faces and they are not permitted to have any form of beard like French, Long etc,
