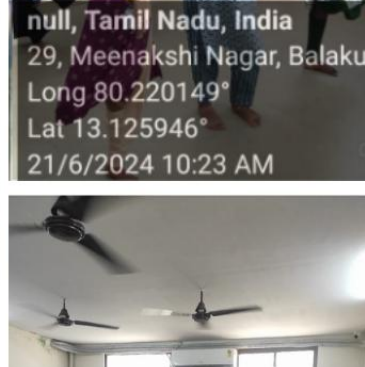


YOGA FOR WOMEN EMPOWERMENT

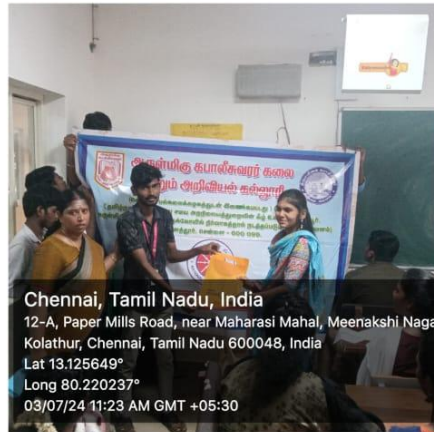


INTERNATIONAL PLASTIC BAG FREE DAY

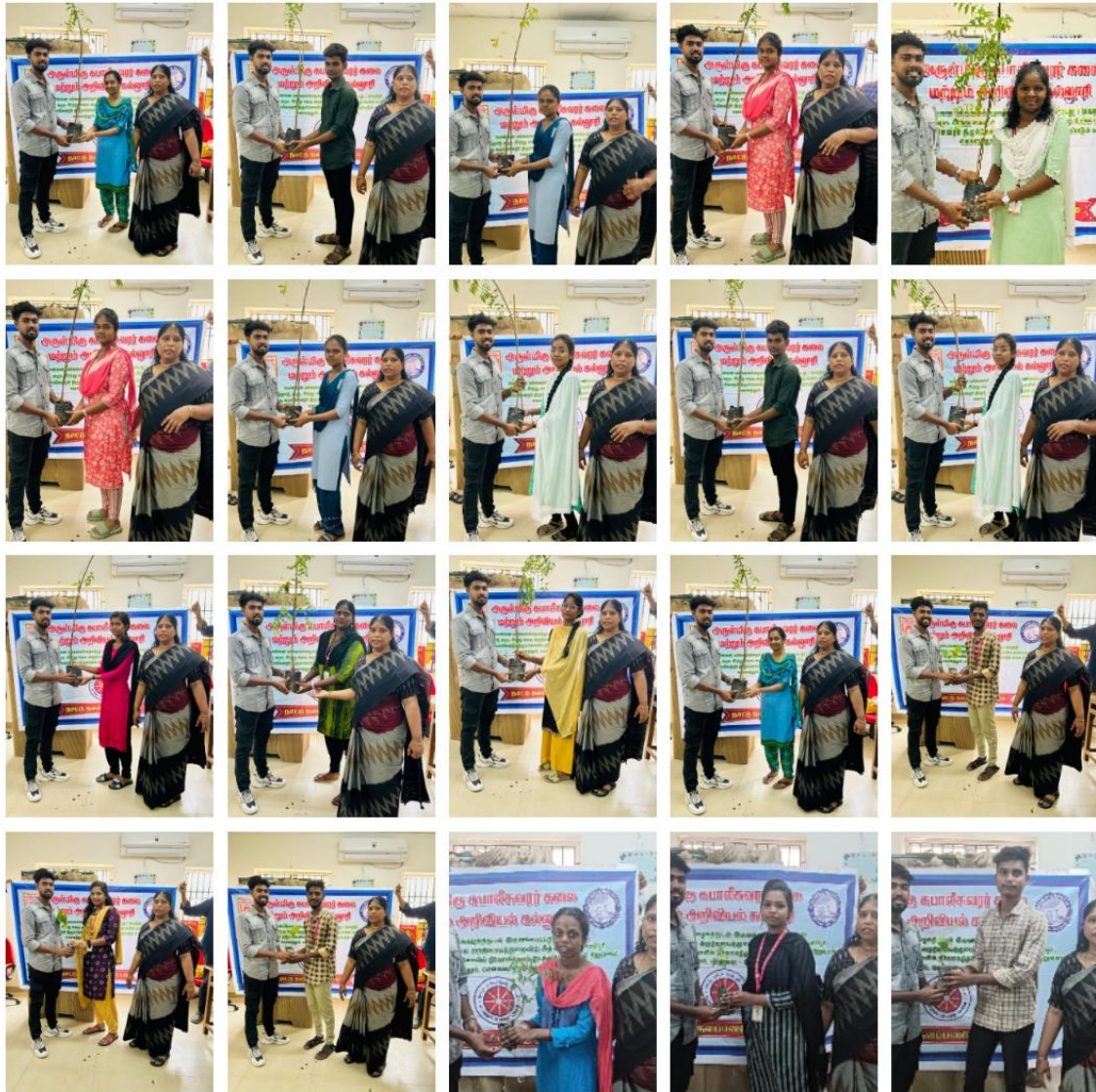


PLANT ONE TREE IN MOTHER'S NAME

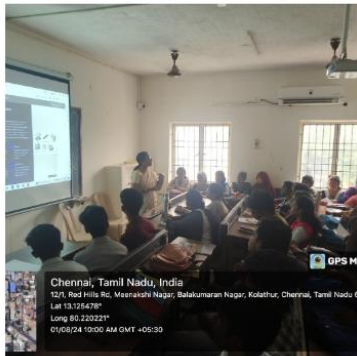


SEMINAR ON BIG DATA AND ITS ARCHITECTURE

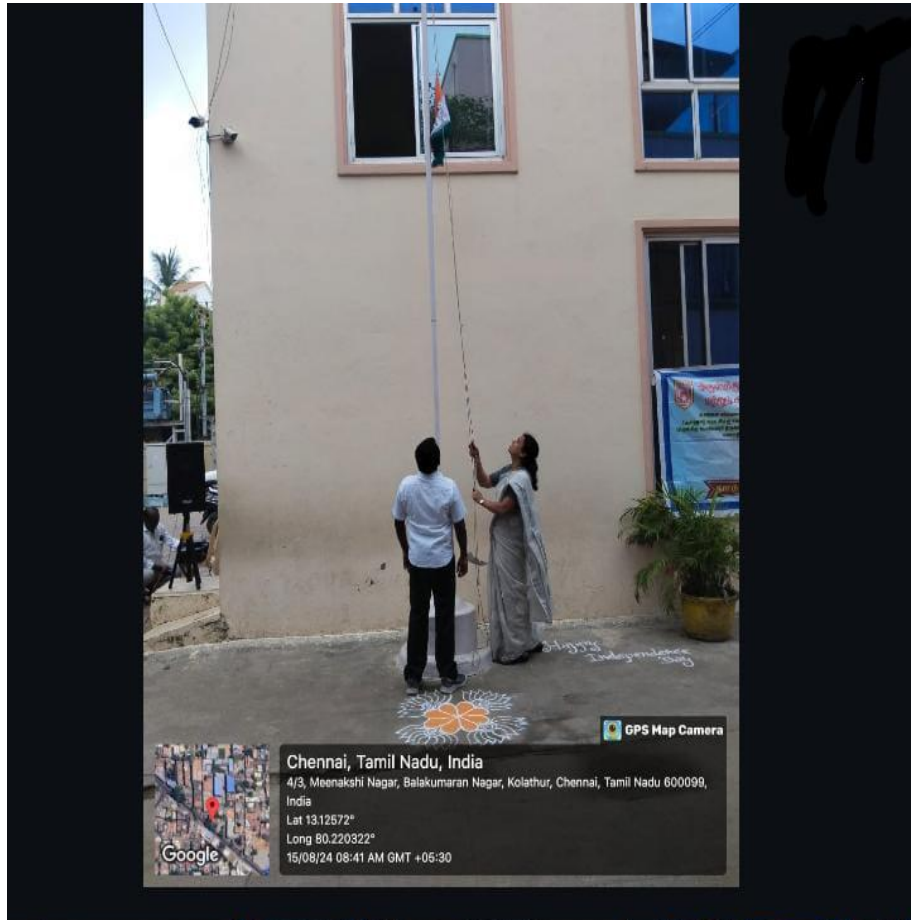
INDEPENDENCE DAY CELEBRATION

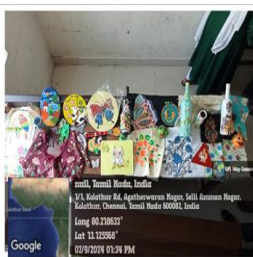

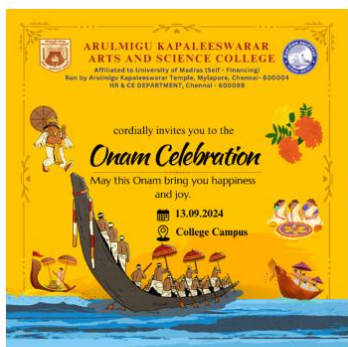


ONAM CELEBRATION

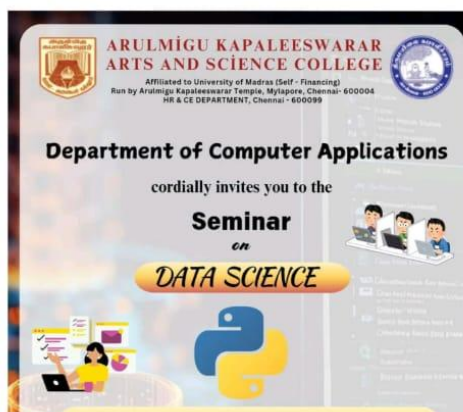

VENUE : College Campus

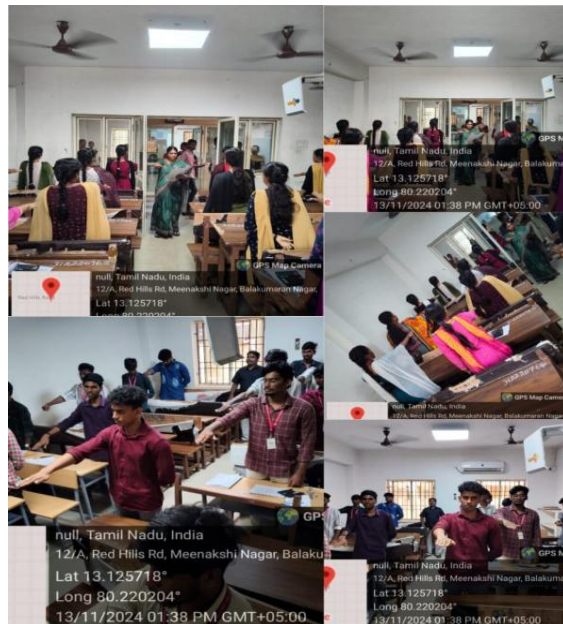
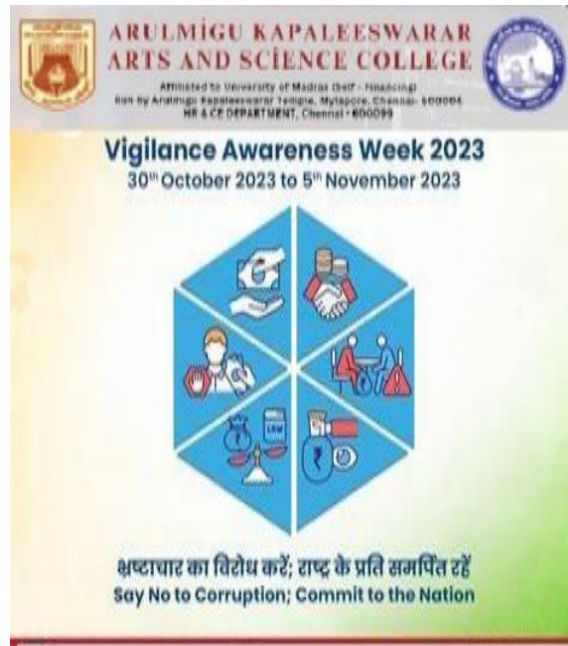

The college is expected to open its permanent campus soon. Totally 750 students were participated in the program.





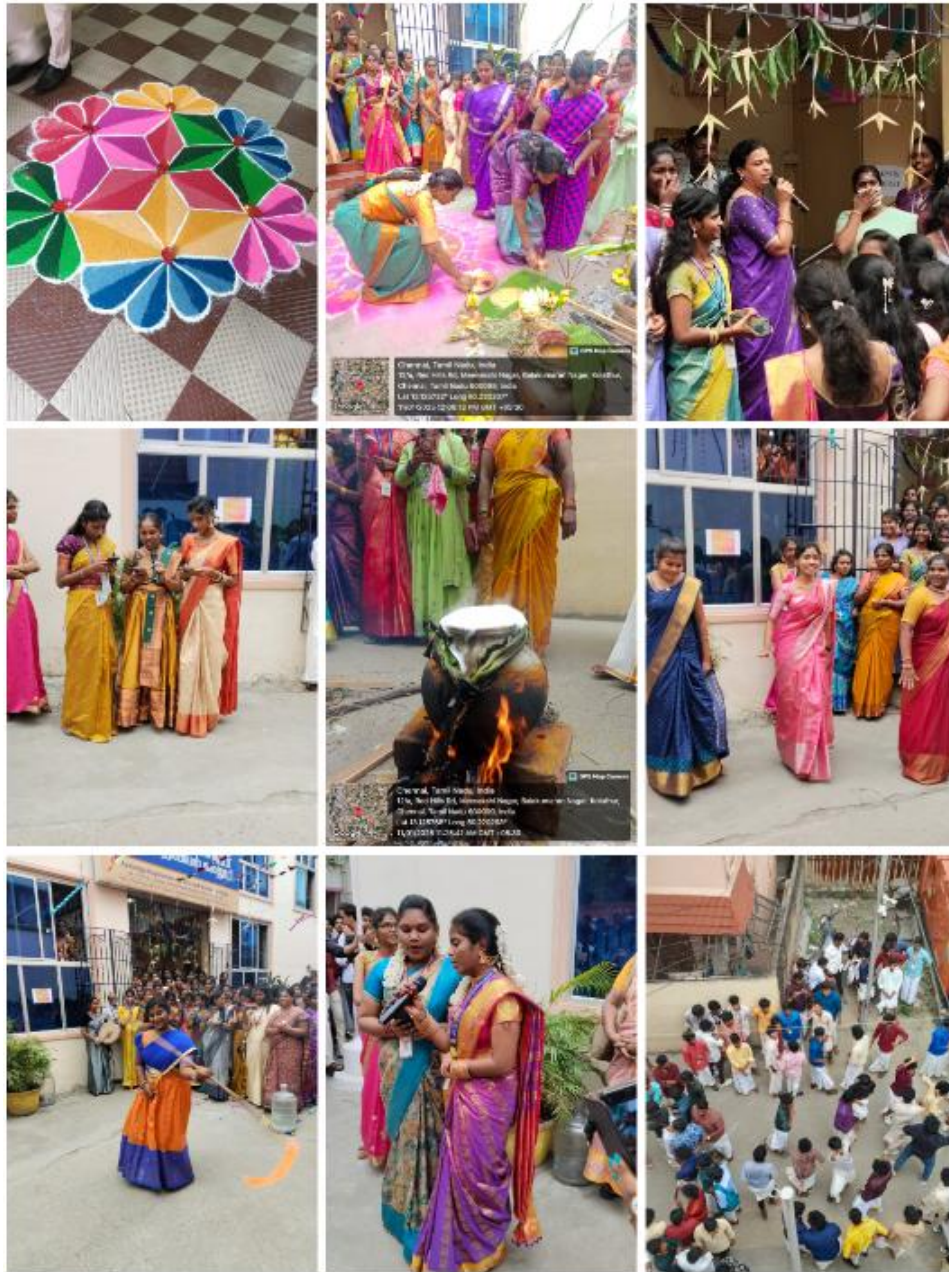
PONGAL CELEBRATION

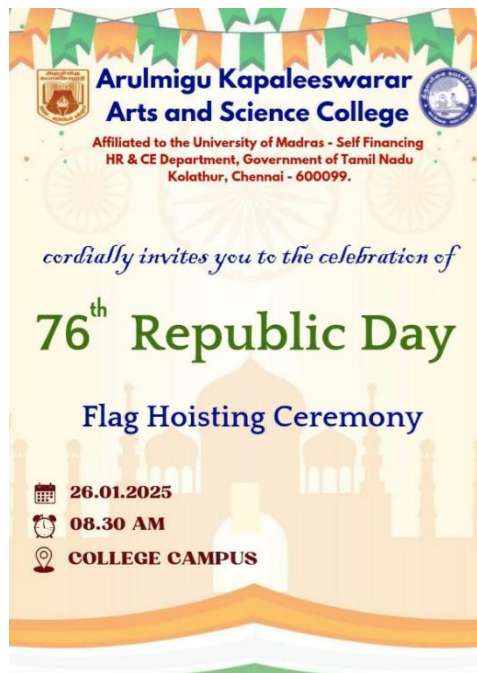
NSS organised a drug free signature campaign on 21st Jan 2025. Around 250 female students participated in the signature campaign. to create awareness among the students.

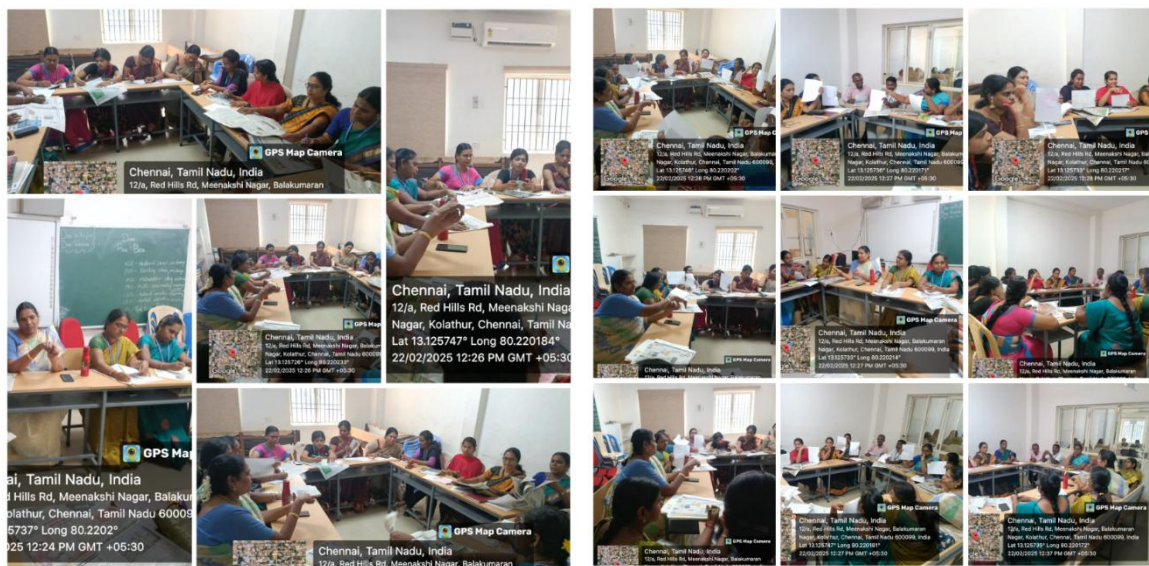

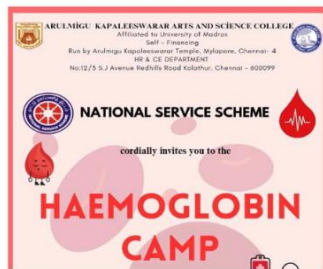
